Election Ballots are in the mail!

You will find in your election package, ballots, instructions for filling out ballots, return envelopes and campaign material for the election in your area.

Please follow the 3 step process for completing the ballot

1. Ballots must be completed by the member and placed in the envelope marked BALLOT
2. The envelope marked BALLOT is then to be placed into the return addressed envelope and sealed
3. The Return addressed envelope is then filled out with the required information on the front. Name, Address, Lodge & Pin

Return envelope must be post stamped no later than Aug 9, 2011

Any ballots received which have not been completed in accordance with the above procedures, or if the envelopes are not sealed will be considered as spoiled ballots.

Counting of the ballots by the Election Committee will commence the third week of August 2011 and results will be forwarded to Lodges and Candidates and posted on the CAW Local 100 Website.
